<input type="checkbox"/> American Indian or Alaska Native	A person having origins in any of the original peoples of North and South America (including Central America), and who maintains tribal affiliation or community attachment.
<input type="checkbox"/> Asian	A person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Indian subcontinent including, for example, Cambodia, China, India, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Pakistan, the Philippine Islands, Thailand, and Vietnam.
<input type="checkbox"/> Black or African American	A person having origins in any of the black racial groups of Africa.
<input type="checkbox"/> Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander	A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Hawaii, Guam, Samoa, or other Pacific Islands.
<input type="checkbox"/> White	A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, the Middle East, or North Africa.

White – Print, for example, German, Irish, English, Italian, Lebanese, Egyptian, etc. ↴

Black or African Am. – Print, for example, African American, Jamaican, Haitian, Nigerian, Ethiopian, Somali, etc. ↴

American Indian or Alaska Native – Print name of enrolled or principal tribe(s), for example, Navajo Nation, Blackfeet Tribe, Mayan, Aztec, Native Village of Barrow Inupiat Traditional Government, Nome Eskimo Community, etc. ↴

Key points to consider:

435 Congressional seats are distributed based on population. (this correlates to the electoral college)

People are recognized by **national descent name**. (According to government standards on race & ethnicity **black/African American people do not descend from any of the original people of the world!**) (lookup standard form 181)

Moor is a historically accurate identifier for those classified as black/African American people & also for many people from the Caribbean and Latin America.

It is integral that we **actively participate** in the 2020 Census & that we **self-identify**. Out of an estimated 42 million black/African Americans in country, 2.1% (over 800k) people were not counted. The Census bureau was sued by five states for miscounting our population. Remember, this is how funds get allocated!

It is very important that we unite & organize now! **Below are FOUR IMPORTANT steps that we advise.**

1. State yes, born in the US for the citizen question make sure to signify that you are a voter.

2. For "Race" select two options: Select **American Native & write in "**Moor**". (The federal government has created hierarchal race codes, to look up Moor, see group code 7H8.)**

3. Also Select **Other & write **Asiatic Moorish**.**

4. Use the paper version of the Census & make a copy for your records.
